An Inclusive Community Where Youth Can Thrive

We're working to create a community where all youth have the supports, resources, and opportunities to thrive.

Youth housed and employed

21 Graduates accessed outreach supports

Graduates in employment or education

40 Employers enhanced their inclusive employment skills

Work 2 Live

Through the Work 2 Live program, we provide housing, employment, access to outdoor recreation, and wraparound supports for youth aged 19-27 facing homelessness. Youth spend 12-24 months living, working, and playing in the mountain community of Whistler, building connections to themselves, community, and the land.

Adventure Sessions

Our Adventure Sessions program offers no-cost access to skiing, snowboarding, mountain biking, and hiking for youth aged 13-27 who are at risk of homelessness in the Sea to Sky Corridor and Metro Vancouver. In partnership with Whistler Blackcomb, the Adventure Sessions have offered equitable access to mountain sports in Whistler since 1997.

875 Visits from youth facing homelessness

30% Youth returned twice or more

45% Visits from youth living in the Sea to Sky Corridor

35% Visits from Indigenous youth



What's New?

We've enhanced our programs to provide holistic, accessible supports every day of the year. Meanwhile, we're investing in preventing, not just reacting to, youth homelessness.



Our Own Private Housing Units

For the first time, we now rent and manage nine beds of housing to provide safe homes for youth.

On-site Overnight Support for Youth

365 days per year, staff are on-site our homes to provide wraparound support.

Zero Ceiling Auntie Program We partner with elders from the Squamish and N'Quatqua Nations to offer cultural supports for youth

Accessible Mental Health Support

Access to low-barrier, traumainformed, virtual counselling in partnership with Dan's Legacy.

New Outdoor Experiences

We now offer hiking alongside snowsports and mountain biking to be more inclusive for youth.

"The empowering was nice, the boost was nice ... because of how self-deprecating I was, I didn't realize I was doing anything or getting anywhere, and when she showed me that list [of accomplishments] it really boosted me up. By 2028 we want to:

- Grow from nine to 22 beds of housing
- Own permanent housing for our programs
- Offer equitable access to the outdoors for all youth facing homelessness in the Sea to Sky
- Empower youth with new opportunities to shape and lead our programs
- Generate sustainable revenue so we can always be here to empower youth
